The Shelf-Stable Food Processors Association (SFPA) is the trade association serving the shelf-stable prepared food industry. Key SFPA Activities

The Shelf-Stable Food Processors Association (SFPA) represents the industry in numerous ways. The following are examples of the many issues which SFPA addresses.

Food safety is a top priority for SFPA and its membership. Through constant monitoring and involvement with regulatory agencies, the organization has been able to deliver timely information and analysis of issues important to the membership. SFPA provides both FSIS and FDA regulatory and technical assistance to its membership, and works to ensure government regulations enhance food safety and do not create unnecessary burdens on the industry.

The **nutrition** profile of processed products is increasingly in the spotlight. SFPA defends the shelf-stable foods industry's efforts to provide wholesome, affordable products to consumers. SFPA is monitoring implementation of the *2020-2025 Dietary Guidelines for Americans*, and the process to update the 2025-2030 edition, to ensure that shelf-stable food products are recognized as a part of healthy dietary patterns. SFPA also continues to monitor policies implemented under the Biden-Harris Administration's National Strategy on Hunger, Nutrition, and Health.

International trade is an integral part to the success of the shelf-stable food industries. The organization focuses efforts on ensuring that international trade, foreign inspections, world markets and sanitary and phytosanitary requirements are designed to facilitate trade. SFPA participates in a Cooperative Service Agreement with USDA's APHIS to facilitate the inspection of foreign meat plants for exporting cooked meat products to the U.S. Further, SFPA is working with allied stakeholders to highlight the negative consequences of the steel and aluminum tariffs on affected industries and to determine the appropriate measures to mitigate these consequences.

SFPA supports **sustainability** initiatives and programs to respond to customers. In fact, the shelf-stable foods industry has been one of the leaders in environmental sustainability. Additionally, SFPA supports the increase of vehicle gross weight in an effort to reduce food miles, reduce carbon footprint, increase fuel efficiency, and reduce costs, among other reasons.

SFPA provides **industry trade leads** to its members by informing them of customers' requests for the purchase of shelf-stable food products. These trade leads have resulted in additional sales and contacts for member companies.

SFPA's Annual Meeting, open attendance Board of Directors meeting and committee meetings provide unparalleled opportunities for processors, importers and suppliers to receive the latest industry and government information that affect their businesses. These events also serve as great **opportunities to network** with other industry leaders and suppliers.
